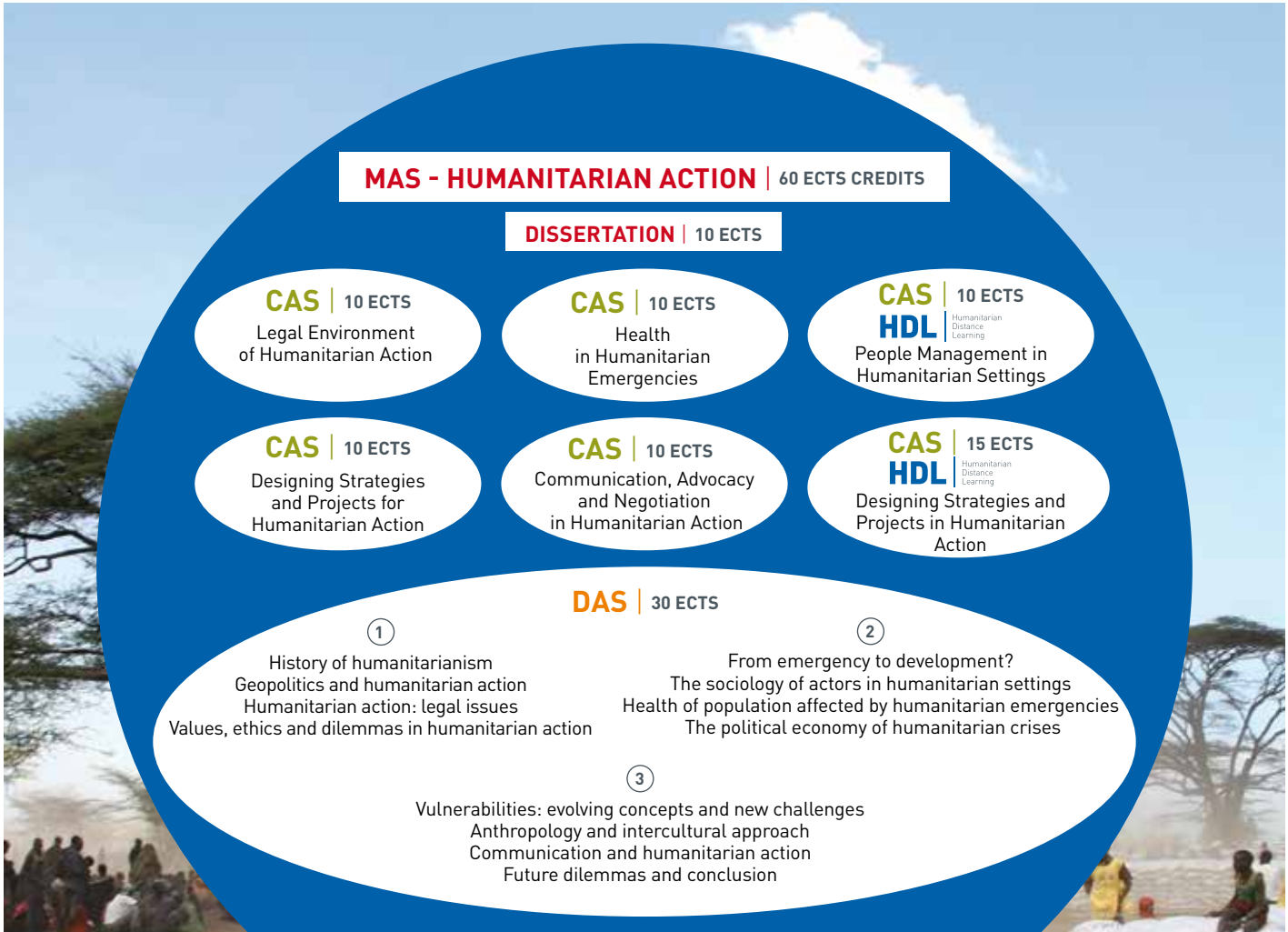

### MASTER OF ADVANCED STUDIES (MAS) IN HUMANITARIAN ACTION

**3-month core curriculum** on the concepts and fundamental issues of humanitarianism (September-December)

#### Research methodology

**Two elective courses** on a specific subject of the student's choice (CAS)

**Dissertation** to submit in June or August

The MAS can be completed in 1-3 years.

### DIPLOMA OF ADVANCED STUDIES (DAS) IN HUMANITARIAN ACTION

**4-month course taught full-time** on humanitarian concepts, contemporary challenges to humanitarian practice including **research methodology** and **research work** to hand over in January.

### CERTIFICATES OF ADVANCED STUDIES (CAS) IN HUMANITARIAN ACTION

**7-week residential / 8-month distance learning programme** of intensive courses on specific subjects.

### THEMATIC SEMINARS (TS)

**One-week intensive** courses on topical themes in humanitarian action.

### MASSIVE ONLINE OPEN COURSE (MOOC)

**Free 5-week** programme on a specific topic.
